Requirements:

- Applicant must be 21 years of age
- Applicant must be a United States citizen
- Applicant must possess a high school diploma, or equivalent
- Applicant must possess a valid State of Tennessee driver's license within 10 days of hire
- Applicant must possess a State of Tennessee EMT license
- Applicant must possess certification as a TN FFI and HAZ-MAT awareness

Application Process:

- Applicant must successfully pass (70%) a written test demonstrating knowledge of the fire service and vehicle operations
- Applicant must successfully complete a physical fitness performance test
- Applicant must successfully complete a practical skill evaluation
- Applicant must successfully pass an interview
- Applicant must submit to a background investigation, which will include a driver history check and criminal history check
- Selected applicants must submit to a pre-employment medical evaluation and drug test

- Employee will be subject to a rotating shift of 24 hours
- Department issued uniforms

Job Description:

The employee will be expected to perform the following job function: fire suppression, emergency medical response, public fire education, public relations activities, public service calls, station duties, pre-fire planning, hydrant testing, training, basic vehicle preventive maintenance, report writing, and other duties as assigned by the Fire Chief. The employee must be able to successfully function in a combination setting, and work within the scope and command structure of a combination fire department.
