

DEPUTY FIRE MARSHAL HIRING NOTICE

The White River Township Fire Protection District is seeking applicants for the full-time position of Deputy Fire Marshal. Applicants for this position must have Fire Inspector I/II and Fire Investigator I or similar training that may be determined equivalent by the District. In addition, all applicants must be citizens of the United States, at least twenty-one (21) years of age, have a high school diploma or equivalent and a valid driver's license. Applicants must have no prior felony convictions and must be able to effectively and accurately communicate the English language. In addition to the general requirements set forth herein, applicants must also meet all additional general and specific requirements as contained in the District's application packet that can be obtained as set forth below. The District Board reserves the right to determine, in its sole discretion, whether applicants have met the minimum eligibility requirements to participate in the hiring process.

The position of Deputy Fire Marshal is a non-merit based position without a permanent rank. However, the District Board has the discretion to grant the applicant a permanent merit rank based on the individual's qualifications, eligibility, and experience. In addition, the District Board may, in its discretion, permit an individual to participate in a promotion process to obtain a permanent merit rank. Applicants wishing to be considered for a merit firefighter or officer position must either be an active member of the 1977 fund, or have current Firefighter I/II and Emergency Medical Technician certifications, and proof of successful completion of the Candidate Physical Ability Test within the past 6 months.

The salary for this position is anticipated to be \$67,883 per year plus a benefit package, which may include health and certain retirement benefits, subject to and conditioned upon qualifications, eligibility and experience.

No applications will be distributed prior to or after the above dates. All completed applications and required supporting documentation must be returned to the Office of the District at the address set forth above to the attention of Fire Marshal Michael Arany no later than February 10, 2017 at 3:00 PM.
